

CIRCULAR

Sub: UGC Guidelines and Bangalore University Regulations on Determination of Uniform Span Period to qualify for a Degree/to keep term in the Second and Third year Degree Courses/Completion of the Degree Programme.

While drawing attention to all the Principals of the affiliated Colleges of Bangalore University offering UG courses regarding the UGC Guidelines on Determination of Uniform Span Period to quality for a Degree published vide D.O. No.F.12-1/2015 (CPP-II) dated:15/10/2015, received from University Grants Commission, New Delhi, and the Bangalore University Regulation regarding duration of a Degree Programme/to keep term in the Second and Third year degree courses/Completion of the Degree Programme are as follows:

The general formula prescribed by UGC for completion of a Degree are as under:

a) Time Span = N+2 years for the completion of Programme.

Where N stands for the normal or minimum duration prescribed for completion of the programme, i.e., five years for all UG courses from the date of joining. Otherwise, he/she has to join the course afresh.

As per the Bangalore University Regulations, with regard to:

- I. **Appearance for the Examination -- A candidate shall apply for all the parts in each University examination when he/she appears for the first time. A candidate shall be considered to have appeared for the examination only if he/she submitted the prescribed application for the examination along with the required fees.**
- II. **CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH CANDIDATES ARE PERMITTED TO KEEP TERM IN THE SECOND AND THIRD YEAR DEGREE COURSES:**
 1. The candidates who have completed attendance in I year (I & II Semesters) Degree shall be eligible to keep term in the II year Degree (III & IV Semesters) provided they have submitted the applications for the examinations of each semester along with the required fees.

All the Principals of the affiliated Colleges of Bangalore University are requested to strictly adhere to the above UGC Guidelines and Regulations of Bangalore University and **not to** admit the students for Re-admission/Transfer of students from one college to another (within and outside Bangalore University jurisdiction) without obtaining the prior permission from the B. University.
