Flexibility of the Programme

- Course is adapted as per NEP 2020, guidelines with holistic and multidisciplinary education approach. The course allows students with a flexibility to combine multi-disciplinary subjects along with vocational courses in Arts/Science.
- There are 'multiple exit options' & appropriate 'certification' at the end of every year. Overall emphasis is on conceptual understanding of Arts/Sciences with skill enhancement papers on latest advances in the field.
- First year exit option includes 'Certificate' in Honours (48 credits)
- Second year exit option includes 'Diploma' in Honours (96 credits)
- Third year exit option includes 'Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Science' (BA/BSc Degree with 140 credits).
- Fourth year exit option includes 'BA Honours/BSc Honours' Degree (180 credits)
