As you are aware, the Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) instituted the prestigious 'Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar (SSB) Prize for Science and Technology' in the year 1957, in commemoration of its founder Director, the late Dr (Sir) Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar, FRS. The SSB Prizes are awarded annually for significant contributions made in various disciplines of science and technology. Each awardee is given a citation, a cash prize of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakh), and a plaque at a formal function, usually presided over by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, who is the President, CSIR.

Nominations are hereby invited for SSB Prizes for the year 2022 from the **Vice-Chancellors of Indian Universities** / Directors of National Laboratories/Institutes/ Bhatnagar Awardees and others. Scientists who are not more than 45 years of age (as of 31.12.2021) are eligible to be nominated. The person(s), nominated for the SSB Prize, should have made significant research contributions through work done primarily in India during the past five years. Kindly ensure that the nominated scientist fulfills all requisite qualifications, criteria and deserves consideration.
