

Pending ratification by the Academic Council and in view of COVID-19 Pandemic, extension of one more year is granted for the students of 2016-17 Batch of Under-graduate degree programmes (**students who have completed the course without any break but have not completed their degrees within the stipulated period as per Bangalore University CBCS Regulations and Clause 2 (b) of UGC Guidelines dt: 15/10/2015**) to appear for the examinations in the failed subjects of odd semester i.e., I, III, V & VII to be held during February/March 2022 and even semester i.e. II, IV, VI & VIII to be held during June/July 2022 examinations. The failed candidates, who have registered for admission during the academic year 2016-17 are permitted to appear for the failed papers/subjects whenever respective semester examinations are being conducted by the University.

This permission is should not be quoted as a precedent and no further requests will be entertained for extension.

The Principals of the affiliated Colleges including the colleges situated under the purview of Bengaluru City University (BCU) & Bengaluru North University (BNU) jurisdiction which were then affiliated to Bangalore University during the academic year 2016-17, are requested to permit the students of 2016-17 batch Register Numbers starts from 16 – series (under UG-CBCS) who have failed in certain subject/s, to appear for the said examinations. They are also requested to display this order in College Notice Boards to give wide publicity. Further, the Principals are also requested to send a letter certifying details of the students who have been permitted to appear for Examinations along with the copies of their marks cards to the Registrar (Evaluation), Bangalore University.
